Students applying for admission to the Radiography Program must complete the following:

- **Attendance at one information session is MANDATORY** for admission.

- **Admission to San Jacinto College:**

- Apply for admission to San Jacinto College via our website at <https://sanjac.edu/admissions/how-to-apply/>
- College Transcripts - If you are a **new first-time** student to San Jacinto College you will need to hand deliver an official sealed transcript (must be issued within the last 60 days) OR request your former college/university to send an official sealed transcript directly to Admissions. All courses completed outside the San Jacinto College District must be evaluated by Admissions. Transcripts should be requested as soon as possible; do not wait until the application period beginning dates to request transcripts.

- **Official Transcripts for Application:**

- College transcripts – Applicants must submit official transcripts from **all** colleges/universities attended, **including** San Jacinto College, **with your application to the Radiography Program**. Applicants will need to request official transcripts be sent to themselves, then save or scan to PDF to upload to the online application. Un-official transcripts printed from college websites will not be accepted.  
\*\*Please order transcripts early to ensure received by the student in time to submit with application by due date\*\*
- Submit a current copy of “what if” degree evaluation from SOS: 2024-2025, AAS, Medical Radiography.

- **Prerequisites:**

BIOL 2301 – Human Anatomy & Physiology I (Lecture)  
 and BIOL 2101 – Human Anatomy & Physiology I (Lab)  
 ENGL 1301 – Composition I  
 MATH 1314 – College Algebra  
 RADR 1201 – Introduction to Radiography  
 HESI EXAM (see below)

\*BIOL 2301/BIOL 2101 must be taken within 5 years of program start date.

\*RADR 1201 must be taken within 3 years of program start date.

**Effective Fall 2022 ALL prerequisite courses must be completed by application deadline.**

- **Required General Education Courses:** Prior to completion of the Associate of Applied Science Degree in Medical Radiography, students will be required to complete the following Gen Ed courses as part of the degree plan. Please see Program Admission Criteria PDF on the Radiography Webpage on “Step 7: Apply to the Medical Radiography Program” for the complete list of courses that fulfill the Humanities or Fine Arts category.

- Psychology 2301 – General Psychology
- Humanities or Fine Arts (3 SCH)

\* All Prerequisite Courses, RADR Program Courses, and required Gen Ed Courses must be completed with a “C” or higher for degree completion.

\* Applicants must have a minimum GPA or 2.0 and be in good academic standing.

- **HESI A2 Exam** – Applicants must submit official HESI A2 Exam scoresheet with all 5 sections. The HESI Exam is a timed, computerized test with a 4.5-hour time limit. The Exam consists of the following 5 sections: Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary/General Knowledge, Math, and Anatomy/Physiology. Students must also complete the Learning Style section however, it will not be scored. The Exam is administered by the San Jacinto Medical Imaging Department on Central Campus. Students applying for the Medical Radiography program may register for an exam session at the Information Session attended (see first section of this document for information session dates). Students may take the exam twice in any given academic year, and all 5 sections must be taken.

The Exam must be taken within 2 years of the program application deadline. Students applying for the San Jacinto College Medical Radiography program must take their Exam through the San Jacinto College Medical Imaging Program administered on Central Campus.

- **Clinical Health Requirements:** After selection into the program but prior to admission, students will be required to complete a criminal background check, urine drug/alcohol screening, and completion of all clinical health requirements (CPR, Health Insurance, Vaccinations, Titters, Physical Exam, etc.)

### **Radiography Program Details**

- Full time schedule (6-9 hour clinical rotations, 3 – 8 hour lecture/lab times)
- Typical school calendar is followed (16 week spring and fall, 13 week summer)

- ARRT first attempt pass rate 94.9% over the past 5 years, 2019-2023.
